
The aim of this guide is to provide an overview of the VET Practitioner Resource. This guide covers:

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
VET Practitioner Resource

The resources are presented in two different sections: **Focus on research** and **Focus on practice**.

Focus on research



The **Focus on research** section presents research-based publications and resources in three categories:

 Teaching and learning – this category contains resources to support practitioners in their daily educational practice and their ongoing professional development. It provides six tables of resources in the following topics: <u>Teaching and learning</u> <u>concepts</u>; <u>Meeting student needs</u>; <u>Modes of delivery</u>; <u>Teaching and learning</u> <u>contexts</u>; <u>Assessment</u>; <u>Professional development</u>.



- Working in the VET sector this category contains information and resources about the VET workforce and being a practitioner, organised within the following topics: Aspects of working life; Qualifications; Regulations and standards; Workforce profile.
- **Educators as researchers** this category contains information and resources for undertaking action research associated with current teaching practice or a funded research project.

The **Focus on practice** section presents practical resources including guides, courses, webinars and more, to assist practitioners in undertaking their daily educational practice and professional development.




There are seven pages of resources under the following categories:

Using the tables of resources

Clicking on any of the topics in the boxes under each category will take you to a page which contains a single table that displays resources for each topic in that category. The table defaults to displaying the resources for the first topic. Click on the tabs within the table to view the resources for the other topics in that category.

The column labelled All resources combines everything from the category in one list.



Each column of the table can be sorted alphabetically. Click on the column heading to sort by that column. Clicking on the column heading again will reverse sort the content.

- For the **Focus on research** tables, the column headings are Resource, Description, Year, Resource type and Cost.
- For the **Focus on practice** tables, the column headings are Resource, Description, Source, Resource type and Cost.

Each column of the table can also be searched. The search bar is just below the topic tabs. The search will look in the content of the topic tab selected. To search within the entire table, select the column All resources, then use the search box.
